VINTAGE NOTES

The 2006 vintage was an extremely cool and late vintage which allowed for the preservation of natural acidity and elegant fruit weight in the resultant wine. The white wines in general display fresh varietal characters typical of a cooler year. The very mild ripening conditions and lower crop levels allowed for full flavour development and ripeness in the Viognier (*vee-on-yeh*). It also allowed for the formation of noble rot on the small batch of Viognier grapes used to produce this wine.

The fruit for this wine was harvested late in the season after allowing the infection of noble rot to form on the grapes concentrating the flavour and sugar levels. The fruit was handpicked, de-stemmed and pressed to tank for fermentation. At the critical point, where sugar and acid balance was achieved, the fermentation was stopped and the wine was filtered and bottled in spring.

ANALYSIS

Alcohol 11.0%, pH 3.44, TA 5.4, R.S 140 g/L

TASTING NOTES

Colour Deep straw with golden hues.

Aroma Stone-fruit, ginger and honeysuckle aromas complemented by the botrytis influence.

Palate Sweet, rich and unctuous but balanced by a crisp acidity and a long, clean finish.
